#### **About Playback Theatre**

Playback Theatre is a form of improvisational theatre practiced in over 40 countries worldwide. It is a spontaneous theatre that reflects back to a gathered audience their view of the world as they experience it.

**In a playback event**, someone in the audience tells a story from their life, chooses the actors to play the different roles, and then we all watch the enactment as the story comes to life with artistic shape and nuance.

**Playback Theatre skills** can be used for a wide variety of disciplines, involving strong teamwork, listening, acting, movement and music. The re-creation of stories is often non-naturalistic; students are encouraged to use metaphor narration, chorus, genre, movement and song.
